We are available when and where our clients need us.

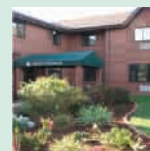

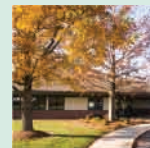

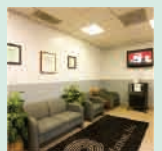

Residential Treatment

Residential treatment combines education, group counseling, individual counseling and self-study, plus family education and counseling. Individuals receive 24 hour support and guidance to promote their substance abuse recovery.

Day Treatment

This program features the same high quality education, group and individual counseling and family education as the residential treatment program. However, it provides the option for the individual to go home in the evenings if a stable environment is available.

Intensive Outpatient (IOP) Treatment

Convenient After work/After school Intensive Outpatient treatment programs fit into an individual's life. This effective treatment assists individuals who do not require residential care, but need an intensive program in order to effectively confront their substance abuse issues.

Aftercare

Aftercare is a series of group counseling sessions which take place after Intensive Outpatient treatment. Aftercare helps individuals transition from more intense levels of care back into their daily lives with work, school and family. Our Alumni program also provides support for those leaving a structured treatment program.
